SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE UNIVERSITY OF ILLINOIS

- In Article III Consideration, the sum "\$114,600.00" is substituted for the sum "\$81,000.00".

Article A-I RESEARCH TO BE PERFORMED BY CONTRACTOR

- (a) The unclassified Scope of Work under this contract entitled, "Structural Framework of the Mississippi Embayment of Southern Illinois" is as follows:
 - 1. Evaluate the older stratigraphic units in southern Illinois by studies of deep drilling that has been done in the area. This will result in improved maps of the Paleozoic strata; the maps will be used to relate the Paleozoic strata to the configuration of the top of basement rocks. The studies will also permit more accurate estimations of the densities of the older strata.
 - Prepare new structural maps of the Ste. Genevieve Fault Zone
 on several horizons to determine the history of movements along
 the fault zone and to establish whether or not the fault zone may
 border on ancient rift.
 - Provide stratigraphic correlation charts for the major stratigraphic units in the New Madrid area to permit uniform and useful nomenclature for all states involved in the New Madrid Study.
 - Prepare a final report which summarized the stratigraphic and structural setting of southern Illinois.
- (b) The Principal Investigator expects to devote the following approximate amount(s) of time to the contract work:
 - H. Schwalb: 20% of his time during 12 months.D. Kolata: 10% of his time during 12 months.
