1. A list of unplanned gas releases for Crystal River # 3 since it went on line in 1977 by date, cause, and amount released.

2. A copy of all information in Docket 50-302, File 3-0-3-a-3, 9-7-77, regarding weld materials and the reactor vessel.

3. The calibration (rate measured by), the number and distance from, what it measures, and whether measurements are averaged or extrapolated(If there are more than one), of radiation monitors at the Reactor Building Vent at Crystal River 13.

4. A list of all studied or proposed sites or locations for low Level Waste Disposal in Florida.

I expect a reply within ten worling days. Because this request is in the public interest, I hereby request a fee waiver.
