Centlemen:

This refers to the inspection conducted by Messrs. Johnson, Kister, and Kohler on July 15-17. 22-25, and 29-31, 1975, of activities at Dresden Nuclear Fower Station Units 1, 2 and 3 authorized by NRC Operating Licenses No. DPR-2, No. DPR-19 and No. DPR-25 and to the discussions of our findings conducted by Messrs. Knop and Johnson with you, Messrs. Palmer and Stephenson, and other numbers of your staff on September 5, 1975.

A copy of our report of this inspection is enclosed and identifies the areas examined during the inspection. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of a selective examination of procedures and representative records, interviews with plant personnel, and observations by the inspectors.

During this inspection, it was found that certain of your activities appear to be in noncompliance with NRC requirements. The items and reference to the pertinent requirements are listed under Enforcement Action in the Summary of Findings Section of the enclosed inspection report.

This notice is sent to you pursuant to the provisions of Section 2.201 of the MRC's "Rules of Practice," Part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations. Section 2.201 requires you to submit to this office within twenty days of your receipt of this notice, a written statement or explanation in reply, including: (1) corrective steps which have been taken by you, and the results achieved; (2) corrective steps which will be taken to svoid further items of noncompliance; and (3) the date when full compliance will be achieved. Except for Infraction No. 1, such a statement or explanation should be provided for each noncompliance item listed. Prior to the conclusion of the inspection, the inspectors determined that corrective action had been taken with respect to Infraction No. 1, and we have no further questions regarding this item at this time.

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In accordance with Section 2.790 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice,"
Part 2. Title 10. Code of Federal Regulations, a copy of this notice,
the enclosed inspection report, and your response to this notice will
be placed in the NRC's Public Document Room. If this report contains
any information that you or your contractors believe to be proprietary,
it is necessary that you make a written application to this office,
within twenty days of your receipt of this notice, to withhold such
information from public disclosure. Any such application must include
a full statement of the reasons for which it is claimed that the
information is proprietary, and should be prepared so to proprietary
information identified in the application is contained as separate
part of the document. Unless we receive an application to withhold
information or are otherwise contacted within the specified time
period, the written material identified in this paragraph will be
placed in the Public Document Room.
