Thank you for informing us of the corrective and preventive actions documented in your letter. These actions will be examined during a subsequent inspection of your licensed program.

With respect to Item A. we have reviewed your response and find no basis for mitigating the severity category previously assigned to this item of noncompliance since the individual's dosimetry equipment was neither misplaced (lost) or damaged in this case.

In accordance with Section 2.790(d) of the NRC's "Rules of Practice", Part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, documentation of findings of the control and accounting procedures for safeguarding special nuclear materials and facility security procedures are exempt from disclosure; therefore Attachment 1 of your response letter will not be placed in the Public Document Room.
