SUBJECT: URANIUM HEXAFLUORIDE LEAK

Approximately 100 personnel evacuated the conversion area of the plant when a minor (less than 5 grams) uranium hexafluoride (UF<sub>6</sub>) leak occurred at about 8:30 a.m. on July 31, 1980, when a pigtail connection developed a leak. Personnel returned to work in less than one hour. There were no exposures of personnel to excessive concentrations of airborne uranium or release of radioactive material to the environment.

A news release is not planned by the licensee nor NRC. Media interest is not expected.

The State of South Carolina has been notified.
