SUBJECT: RECORD OF TELEPHONE CONVERSATION WITH ED FRANCIS,  
DISTRICT III ENGINEER ON AUGUST 15, 1980

At H. J. Miller's request, on August 15, 1980, I telephoned and spoke with Ed Francis, WYDEQ-LQD District III Engineer, regarding his August 4, 1980, letter concerning the planned approval of the Ogle Petroleum, Inc., State Mining Permit by the Department of Environmental Quality - Land Quality Division. I reported that NRC had no objection to the proposed letter of approval or contents of the Permit to Mine. During the course of the conversation, I indicated to Mr. Francis that NRC was considering requesting OPI to install two deep monitoring wells in the sand stringers below the ore zone in Mine Unit 1.

DEQ, AT MY REQUEST, FORWARDED THEIR PERMIT AND ASSOCIATED CONDITIONS TO US FOR REVIEW PRIOR TO <sup>THEIR</sup> LICENSING. THE SPECIFIC PURPOSE OF ROTHFLEISCH'S CALL WAS TO INDICATE BEFORE DEQ TOOK ACTION THAT THERE WOULD LIKELY BE SOME DIFFERENCES IN OUR ACTIONS TO GIVE THEM SOME OPPORTUNITY TO MAKE THEIR PERMIT ACTION CONSISTENT WITH OURS. FRANCIS INDICATED THEY HAD NO PROBLEM WITH OUR CONDITIONS BEING DIFFERENT. LHM 9/16

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
