Proposed Changes to Environmental Technical Specifications

Pursuant to 10CFR50.90 and Section 5.6.3 of the Environmental Technical Specifications (ETS), Connecticut Yankee Atomic Power Company (CYAPCO) hereby proposes to amend its operating license number DPR-61.

Attachment 1 is a proposed change, and the basis thereof, as a revision to the Appendix B ETS of DPR 61, proposing to delete Section 4.2, Shad Monitoring Program.

As such, this change does not affect the environmental impact of plant operation. It has been reviewed by CYAPCO pursuant to 10CFR50.59; 10CFR50, Appendix I; 10CFR20; and 40CFR190, as appropriate, and has not been found to constitute an unreviewed environmental impact. Cost/benefit analysis is not applicable in this instance. The Connecticut Yankee Environmental Review Board has reviewed and approved the change and concurred in the above determination.

In reviewing the proposed change pursuant to 10CFR170, CYAPCO has determined this change to be a Class II Amendment. The basis for this conclusion is that the change is an administrative shift in determining the shad population from the Licensee to a state agency, who will continue to generate population estimates each year from commercial catch data. The change has no safety or


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environmental significance. Therefore, enclosed is a check in the amount of \$1,200 (twelve hundred dollars) as full payment of the amendment fee.


