- Revise PPI Drawing Nos. 109-55D0024, Revision B and 109-55D0025, Revision B, to show dimensions, welds and materials of construction important to safety. Complete fabrication drawings should not be submitted.
- The design change to PPI Drawing No. 32216, Sheet 1 of 2, Revision J, shown in View D does not appear to be consistent with good engineering practice. Please justify the lack of full penetration welds at the corners of the cask.
- 3. In order to consider renewal of the packaging design, please justify the lack of protection provided to prevent crushing of the neoprene seals in the 30-foot drop test.
