In your letter dated June 14, 1979, you presented the results of the 1979 inspections of the feedwater nozzles and the Control Rod Drive return line nozzles for Brunswick Units 1 and 2. The inspection report was reviewed by our contractor, Franklin Research Center, for conformance with the recommendations discussed in NUREG-0312.

We agree with our contractor's finding that the 1979 inspection program was acceptable. We also agree with their recommendation to develop an inspection program for the apron area below the CRD return line nozzle and the stagnant stainless steel return line. This concern will be addressed in NUREG-0619, which was issued for comment on June 5, 1980.
