
Dear Mr. Denton:

By letter to you dated October 23, 1980, Arkansas Power & Light Company asked for an extension of time in which to request a hearing on the referenced Orders for modification of the licenses for Arkansas Nuclear One, Units Nos. 1 and 2. Alternatively, if the request for an extension was denied, the letter was to be treated as a request for hearing.

Subsequent to the transmittal of that letter, the NRC Staff issued Supplement No. 3 to I&E Bulletin 79-01B, which revised the requirements imposed by the Orders. Supplement No. 3 has resolved the concerns which AP&L had in timely responding to the Orders.

Accordingly, AP&L hereby withdraws the alternative requests for an extension of time or for a hearing made in its October 23 letter to you.
