This is in further response to your letter of August 25, 1980 in which you requested several categories of documents pertaining to Crystal River Unit 3.

Please find enclosed the document entitled "Response to NRC Request for Information on Reactor Vessel Material Surveillance Program of Crystal River III." Portions of this document contain information pertaining to welds which is confidential business (proprietary) information. This information is being withheld from public disclosure pursuant to Exemption (4) of the Freedom of Information Act (5 U.S.C. 552(b)(4)) and 10 CFR 9.5(a)(4).

Pursuant to 10 CFR 9.9 of the Commission's regulations, it has been determined that the information withheld is exempt from production or disclosure, and that its production or disclosure is contrary to the public interest. The persons responsible for this denial are the undersigned and Mr. Harold R. Denton, Director, Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation.

This denial may be appealed to the Commission's Executive Director for Operations within 30 days from the receipt of this letter. As provided in 10 CFR 9.11, any such appeal must be in writing, addressed to the Executive Director for Operations, U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Washington, DC 20555, and should clearly state on the envelope and in the letter that it is an "Appeal from an Initial FOIA Decision."

This completes NRC action on your request.

In light of the fact that the following information is not available in the (IPDR) at Crystal River Public Library in Crystal River, Florida and pursuant to 5 U.S. Codes, Section 552, The Freedom of Information Act, I formally request the following information.

1. A list of unplanned gas releases for Crystal River # 3 since it went on line in 1977 by date, cause, and amount released.
2. A copy of all information in Docket 50-302, File 5-0-3-a-3, 9-7-77, regarding weld materials and the reactor vessel.
3. The calibration (rate measured by), the number and distance from, what it measures, and whether measurements are averaged or extrapolated (if there are more than one), of radiation monitors at the Reactor Building Vent at Crystal River #3.
4. A list of all studied or proposed sites or locations for Low Level Waste Disposal in Florida.

I expect a reply within ten working days. Because this request is in the public interest, I hereby request a fee waiver.
