This refers to the inspection conducted by Mr. Sanders of this office on September 17-18, 1974 at Rowe, Massachusetts of activities authorized by AEC License No. DPR-3 and to the discussions of our findings held by Mr. Sanders with Mr. Jones at the conclusion of the inspection.

Areas examined during this inspection included: displacement of the safety injection system pipe hangers, installation of hydraulic restraints to the pressurizer, plant modifications for the effects of a postulated pipe break outside cont internet and thin wall valve verification program. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspector.

Within the scope of this inspection, no violations or safety items were observed.
