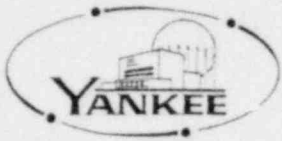

Dear Sir:

Reference (b) indicated that we would supply you the schedule requested by Reference (c) by July 2, 1976. Our staff has reviewed the request for information in Reference (c) and has developed the following schedule:

- (1) Identify the guidelines in Standard Review Plan 9.5.1 which are presently met, and discuss how this is done.

Response: This information will be supplied to you by January 1, 1977.

- (2) Identify the guidelines for which modifications, procedural changes, or enhanced training of personnel are underway or planned, such that the guidelines will be met in the near future.

Response: This information will be supplied to you by July 1, 1977.

- (3) Indicate which of the guidelines you do not now meet or do not intend to meet in the future. For such items, you should provide a basis for your position.

Response: This information will be supplied to you by July 1, 1977.

As you are aware, in March and April of 1975, Inspection and Enforcement Bulletins No. 75-04 and 75-04A were sent to all operating plants. These required an extensive review and revision of policies and procedures, as well as requiring provision of fire prevention and fire suppression equipment throughout the plant. We have complied with those requirements and have reported to the Inspection and Enforcement Office on our compliance. The information is on file with that office if you wish to refer to it.

We trust that our approach and schedule are satisfactory.
