This refers to the inspection conducted by J. E. Konklin of this office on August 26-28, 1980, of activities at the Perry Nuclear Plant Project, Units 1 and 2, authorized by NRC Construction Permits No. CPPR-148 and No. CPPR-149 and to the discussion of our findings with G. W. Groscup and others of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.

The enclosed copy of our inspection report identifies areas examined during the inspection. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of a selective examination of procedures and representative records, observations, and interviews with personnel.

No items of noncompliance with NRC requirements were identified during the course of this inspection.
