I request that any records located as a result of your search be made available for inspection and copying. At the time they are made available, it will be determined whether it is necessary to reproduce any of them. If you determine that some or all of the records are exampt from release under FOIA. please notify me in writing which exceptions you believe cover the materials you are not releasing, and make available the remainder of the records to the extent that they are "reasonably segrgable", in accordance with the FOIA, from the records you have determined to be exempt.

CDP is a research and education project of the International Center and has a continuing interest in the rational extension of technology, pareticularly abroad. This request on their behalf is, therefore, "in the public interest, because furnishing the information can be considered as primarily benefiting the general public" and any applicable fees should be waived as permitted by the Act. In the event that a search is required and you are unwilling to waive search fees, I would appreciate your advising me in advance. CDP's need for information requested by this letter is urgent.
