Dear Mr. Goodwin:

The Commission has issued the enclosed Amendment No. 52 to Facility Operating License No. NPF-1 for Trojan Nuclear Plant. The amendment consists of changes to the Technical Specifications in response to your application dated September 30, 1980.

The amendment revises the corporate (off-site) organization for support of the Trojan Nuclear Plant by placing all nuclear support activities in a single corporate division.

Since the amendment does not change the off-site technical and managerial support functions, but only involves a reorganization of nuclear support functions and titles, it does not involve significant new safety information of a type not considered by a previous Commission safety review of the facility. It does not involve a significant increase in the probability or consequences of an accident, does not involve a significant decrease in safety margin, and therefore does not involve a significant hazards consideration. We have also concluded that there is reasonable assurance that the health and safety of the public will not be endangered by this action and that issuance of the amendment will not be inimical to the common defense and security.

We have evaluated the potential for environmental impact of plant operation in accordance with the enclosed amendment. We have determined that the amendment does not authorize a change in effluent types or total amounts beyond that previously reviewed nor an increase in power level, and will not result in any significant environmental impact. Having made this determination, we have further concluded that the amendment involves an action which is insignificant from the standpoint of environmental impact and pursuant to 10 CFR 51.5(d)(4) that an environmental impact statement or negative declaration and environmental impact appraisal need not be prepared in connection with the issuance of this amendment.
