Gentlemen:

In accordance in your letter of June 11, 1980, attached are proposed TS changes. These proposed TS will meet the intent of the model TS, in that redundancy in decay heat removal capability will be provided.

Because ANO-1 utilizes TS which are not in the standardized format, wording of the proposed TS is quite different. We feel, however, that our proposed TS meet the intent of the model TS.

Many of the model TS are already in place for ANO-2 because Standardized TS are utilized. Therefore, only those proposed TS which change existing ANO-2 TS are submitted herein.

AP&L has determined this to be a Class III amendment because it involves a single issue. Accordingly, a check in the amount of \$4,400 is attached as remittance for both ANO-1 and ANO-2.
