Mr. President;

You have undoubtedly heard by now that the Pennsylvania Congressional delegation is looking into possible federal assistance for Metropolitan Edison Co. and its customers. This is to erase the gross financial burden of the Three Mile Island accident and its necessary cleanup. The nation is benefitting from lessons learned at TMI and I feel the nation should help those of us affected by the resultant financial burden.

Along with your support of federal grants, you could help ease the burden on the company and the customers by supporting Nuclear Regulatory Commission Action for the immediate return of TMI Unit 1 to service. This would be a substantial aid in relieving replacement power costs.
