

Dear Mr. Bachmann:

This is in response to your letter to me, with copies to Messrs. Hill and Schink and enclosures. Unfortunately the following items were omitted from the packet of enclosures:

- (1) The Physical Security Plan, Receipted 20 May 1980. Perhaps it may have been omitted due to size or for reasons with which I am not familiar; and
- (2) Page 56 of the Technical specifications was incomplete and illegible.

Finally, the handwritten chronology of the licensing was helpful, however, I note that the 1968 amendment to increase the reactor's power to 1 MW was issued August 29, 1968 not August 2.

As stated in your letter we await opies of the cobalt irradiation material and the accelerator facility descriptions and licenses.

In closing, I request that you inquire of counsel for Citizens For Nuclear Reactor Safety, Inc. whether as a result of your response, she intends to amend her Petition for Leave to Intervene and, if so, when such amendment will be filed.
