We have reviewed your Physical Security Plan for the Dresden Station submitted as a proprietary attachment to your letter of May , 1974. We find that the Plan complies with the requirements of 10 CFR 50.34(c), conforms to Regulatory Guide 1.17 dated June 1973, and is acceptable.

Accordingly, your plan and the information under item 1 of the letter are deemed to be commercial or financial information within the meaning of 10 CFR Part 9, Section 9.5(a)(4) and shall be subject to disclosure only in accordance with the provisions of Section 9.10 of Part 9.
