


Gentlemen:


Given the uncomfortable situation that the radioactive waste burial grounds have been in these past few years, we, at Hartford Hospital, view this proposal as a positive measure towards alleviating the shortage of available burial space and also the administrative and economic burden imposed by the present disposal methods that licensed facilities must utilize. The fact that the proposed rulemaking presents a negligible environmental and individual radiological impact demonstrates the viability of this action without compromising the general public's welfare.


This institution functions within a Non-Agreement State, but, these proposed alternatives will be of great value to the Agreement States, should they adopt them, and of possible use to us although it is much more difficult to deal with these matters at the state and local levels of government in Connecticut. We look forward to additional proposals that would be instrumental in remedying the radwaste burial and disposal problems throughout the United States.
