
This is in response to your letter dated September 11, 1980, which transmitted a page change to your Fundamental Nuclear Material Control Plan.

We have determined that this revision is in accordance with the provisions of 10 CFR 70.32(c) in that it does not decrease the effectiveness of your material control and accounting program, and that approving this change will not endanger the common defense and security and that it is otherwise in the public interest to do so. Accordingly, effective immediately, License Condition 2.1 of Amendment No. MPP-1 to your License No. SNM-23 is hereby revised to read as follows:

- 2.1 The licensee shall follow the Fundamental Nuclear Material Control Plan submitted January 23, 1975, as revised according to the schedule of revisions dated May 15, 1980, as revised on September 11, 1980, and as amended in accordance with the provisions of 10 CFR 70.32(c).

We have determined that the enclosure to your letter dated September 11, 1980, contains information of a type specified in 10 CFR 2.790(d). Accordingly, pursuant to Section 2.790(d)(1), such information is deemed to be commercial or financial information within the meaning of 10 CFR 9.5(a)(4) and shall be subject to disclosure only in accordance with the provisions of 10 CFR 9.12.
