MEMO OF TELEPHONE CONVERSATION

On July 27, 1979, I spoke with Eldon Brunner, Branch Chief, Reactor Operations and Nuclear Support, Region I. I asked Eldon three questions:

- Who was with William Raymond, Reactor Inspector, in the third vehicle leaving from RO-I to TMI at 1:00 PM on 3/28/79?
- 2. Could you send me the chronologies of RO-I people on site that you prepared?
- 3. What was the logic in not sending Haverkamp (P/I) or Lazarus with the initial wave of inspectors to the site on 3/28/79?

Eldon responded:

- William Raymond was very familiar with the site and was alone in the third vehicle.
- 2. The chronology he has involves up to 12 vehicles dispatched to the site. He is transmitting a copy to me.
- 3. When the call came in on 3/28/79, we learned they had declared a general emergency with no indication of significant radiation. It was evident they were in a state of confusion so we kept our management team here at the RO-I IRC. We sent our H.P. people and investigators (all Reg. I investigators were on site within the first day). This included Gallina who was our man in charge of Emergency Operations.
