  - NUREG-0694, "TMI-Related Requirements for New Operating Licenses", Issued June 1980.

In Reference 1, we forwarded to you a number of "Post-TMI Requirements" for Three Mile Island Unit No. 1 (TMI-1). Reference 1, which should not be interpreted to modify any of the requirements or schedules of the Commission's Orders of August 9, 1979 or March 6, 1980, also sought a response. The purpose of this letter is to seek modification of that response because of the circumstances relating to the current shutdown status of TMI-1.

In response to the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board Memorandum on Board Questions of September 12, 1980, the staff identified, in response to Board Question 1, certain additional items described in NUCCG-0694 (Reference 2), not previously identified, as items the staff believes should be prerequisites for restart of TMI-1. These are set forth in Part A of the enclosure to this letter. In addition, in response to Board Question 2, the staff identified certain requirements described in NUREG-0694 which are dated requirements of Reference 1, but which the staff believes should be completed prior to restart of TMI-1. These are set forth in Part B of the enclosure to this letter. The requirements listed in Parts A and B of the enclosure are consistent with the position taken by the staff in the TMI-1 restart proceeding.

We request that your response to Reference 1 include the additional items set forth in Parts A and B of the enclosure which the staff believes should be made prerequisites to restart.
