I, PAUL WILLIAM JONES, hereby make the following statement to Charles H. Weil, who has identified himself to me as an Investigator of the United States Nuclear Regulatory Commission. I make this statement freely with no threats or promises of reward having been made to me.

I have worked for McGean Chemical plant for the last fourteen years. Doing the period from 1970 to 1975, I drove the dumpster for Chemetron. During the years between 1974 & 1975 I removed several dumpster boxes of broken up concrete from 21 Bldg at the plant. The broken up concrete had been taken from under a tank in 21 Bldg. I took the boxes of broken concrete over to the plant dump. The dump is located on East 27th St. Newburgh, Hts. I unloaded the boxes down at the bottom of the dump. At the time I drove the concrete boxes at the bottom of the dump I was employed by Chemetron. On Sept 3, 1980, I went over to the dump. The area that I dumped the boxes was covered with land fill. During the time of fourteen years my employment with McGean Chemical Co., plant, the boxes of concrete were the only boxes that I took out of 21 Bldg to the plant dump or anywhere. I was the only dumpster driver employed in the plant.

I have read the foregoing statement consisting of 2 pages. I have made any necessary corrections, and I have initialed those corrections. This statement is the truth to the best of my knowledge and belief.
