MOTION TO SUPPLEMENT FURTHER CONTENTIONS

In its submission of November 7, 1980, the Carolina Environmental Study Group ("CESG") advanced two additional contentions which are now pending before the Board. See Memorandum and Order Regarding Applicant's Motion for Summary Disposition at p. 6 (November 26, 1980). The undersigned counsel have just recently agreed to represent CESG with respect to these two contentions. Before the Board rules on whether or not to admit these contentions in the McGuire hearing, we seek the opportunity to supplement CESG's request with a memorandum of law.

We therefore request that the Board rule that, within 10 days of its order, CESG may file a memorandum addressing its contentions # 5 and 6. We of course would have no objection to the Board providing an additional 10 days for the applicant and staff to file any further response they may deem appropriate.

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
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
