The inspection involved 41 inspector-hours onsite by one NRC inspector. The inspection was begun during regular hours; 12 inspector-hours were accomplished during offshift periods.

Access Controls and IE Circular 80-09 regarding plant communications systems.

Results: The licensee was found to be in compliance with NRC requirements within the 20 areas examined during the inspection except for the following 5 areas:

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Region I Form 167 (August 1979) 1.a. Security Organization - member of security force not qualified in one area (Infraction).

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- b. Security Organization security procedure not consistent with Security Plan (Deficiency).
- Physical Barriers (Protected Area) isolation zone not maintained as required (Infraction).
- 3.a. Testing and Maintenance communications device not tested at required frequency (Infraction).
  - b. Testing and Maintenance door alarm not testec as required (Infraction).
- Response security assistance arrangement not documented (Deficiency).
- Locks, Keys and Combinations failure to implement key control procedure (Infraction).
