Gentlemen:

I understand that amendments are being proposed to NRC Regulations Nos. 30, 32, 70 and 150 to allow the recycling of scrap metal contaminated by "low level" radiation as uncontrolled metal to the market place and used in any number of consumer or capital equipment products, such as automobiles, furniture, cooking utensils, personal items (belt buckles) and coins. These items would be unsafe for human use and such contamination is unthinkable and criminal.

I urge that other disposal of nuclear waste products be found and these proposed amendments be abandoned and scrapped.
