As you know, the amended Act provides that if some parts of a requested file are exempt from release that "reasonably segregable" portions shall be provided. I, of course, reserve my right to appeal any such deletions.

If you determine that any of the requested material is exempt from release, I would appreciate your advising me as to which exemptions you believe cover the material you are not releasing.

As you know, the amended Act permits you to reduce or waive fees if that is "in the public interest because furnishing that information can be considered as primarily benefitting the public." I believe this request plainly fits that category and ask that you waive all fees.
