COMMENTS ON MILLSTONE GUARD TRAINING PLAN

Our review of the plan indicates that it requires only a limited number of revisions to be acceptable.

Specific Comments

- 1.2.1.3B Add the following information within this section of the plan: "The requirement for a member of the security force to use a hearing aid shall not decrease the effective performance of the individual assigned security job duties during normal or emergency operations".
- 1.5 Delete the reference to (\pm 25%).
- 1.6 Add to this section a commitment that the documents completed during initial and requalification examinations will be retained for at least a two year period.
- 2.2.6 Add to this section a commitment that test results will be documented and retained on site for at least a two year period.
- 2.4 Delete the reference to (\pm 25%).
- 3.0 Add a reference to night firing for familiarization.
Delete the reference to (\pm 25%).
- 4.1 Since the handgun course is not the National Police Course, identify the equivalent nationally recognized course used.
- 4.3 Delete the reference to (\pm 25%).
- 5.3 Within this section, list the personal equipment meeting the requirements of Appendix B. V. 5.

The Job Analysis Appendix I Worksheets must include the crucial guard functions and duties identified in NUREG-0674. The specific sections requiring revision are identified as follows:
