Discussion:

On October 28 and 29, 1980, G. Eadie, J. Hickey (SD) and J. Buchanan (IE) met with the EPA staff at the Las Vegas Laboratory to discuss the NRC's needs for a Quality Assurance-Cross-Check Standards Program. The meetings were very productive and resulted in an agreement that the EPA would propose several tasks to meet the NRC's needs in the QA area. Specifically, the EPA will propose a program for uranium decay chain series standards and cross-checks for soil and air particulate filter type samples. J. Buchanan indicated that NRC will be able to fund such programs under the existing inter-agency agreement, and that the NRC is most anxious to have the EPA establish such programs.

On October 30 to November 4, 1980, Eadie traveled to Edgemont, S.D. to observe the BPNL field team at work on the Edgemont Cleanup Action Program. The work is progressing well and in a timely fashion. To date, 451 survey requests have been received, out of a total number of 748 locations. BPNL/State have completed radiological surveys as follows:

Structures Passing NRC's Criteria	= 243
Structures Failing NRC's Criteria	= 13
Structures to be Retested	= 49

BPNL has been able to complete about 30 structures per week; therefore, at least 7 more weeks of field work will be required to complete the present 451 requests for survey. BPNL will run newspaper ads and may also phone the remaining homeowners in order to survey all structures within Edgemont, Dudley and Cottonwood.

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
