Dear Mr. Haass;

This is a Freedom of Information Act Request.

In accordance with the provisions of the FOIA, I hereby request copies of all of the "exceptions, alternatives, or clarifications" which nuclear utilities, nuclear steam system suppliers (NSSS) and architect/engineers (A/Es) have been granted for operations or construction QA programs. I understand that there may be a fee for these copies; I agree to pay that fee when billed.

I DO NOT wish to have copies of the complete Quality Assurance program; I am requesting only that portion of the program that lists the exceptions, clarifications, or alternates to ANSI standards and Regulatory Guides listed in your Standard Review Plan (SRP 17.1 and 17.2).

I am only interested in those exceptions, clarifications or alternatives which have been accepted by your Branch or by the NRC.

I would appreciate it very much if you would list the exceptions by utility/NSSS/AE. I would also appreciate it if you would list the date that you (or some other Branch of the NRC) accepted those particular exceptions/clarification/alternatives (i.e. the date that you approve their program.) If a particular utility uses a topical QA Program, I only request the exceptions/clarification/alternates for the topical; I do not need to have that repeated for each plant/facility which uses the topical.

I have obtained the Topical QA Program for TVA. I do not need the above information for that utility unless they have modified their exceptions in 1981.

Thank you in advance for your expeditious handling of this request.
