SECY-A-80-188 - Petition for a Hearing in the Matter
of the Proposed Decontamination of the Dresden Nuclear
Power Station

The Commission by a vote of 3-1 (Chairman Ahearne dissenting) approved an Order, with modifications suggested by Commissioner Gilinsky, to require that the applicant, NRC staff, and the petitioners address additional questions regarding other license amendments which may be required.

Chairman Ahearne would have preferred to issue a notice offering an opportunity for hearing on the proposed decontamination; his dissenting views are attached to the Order. (OGC)
