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COMMENTS ON ZIMMER NUCLEAR POWER STATION GUARD TRAINING AND QUALIFICATION PLAN

Introductory Comment

A detailed review of this plan reflects that it requires revision prior to its being acceptable. Specific comments concerning individual sections of the plan are incorporated in the following section.

Specific Comment

- 2.1 The Implementation Schedule must be revised to commit to training all members of the security force in their assigned duties 30 days prior to initial fuel load.
- 2.2 This section must be revised to specifically commit to all of the following provisions of Appendix B.I.B.1.b.
 - a) Vision
 - b) Hearing
 - c) Diseases
 - d) Addiction
 - e) Incapacitation
- 2.3 This section must conform to the requirements of Appendix B which state that all CAS operators and armed members of the seucrity force will undergo a mental examination by a licensed physican, psychiatrist, psychologist or person trained to detect emotional instability. This examination must be performed prior to assuming security duties. Continued observation by a supervisor must also be included in this commitment.
- 2.4 Revise this section to include the details of the physical fitness test for the security force required by the regulation.
- 2.6 Add a statement that the physical regualification will be performed at least once every 12 months.
- 2.8.4 Add a statement that this documentation will be maintained on site for a minimum of two years.
 - 2.9 Add a commitment to meet the requirements of Appendix B.III.A in this section.
- 2.10 This section must state the numbers of rounds (.38 and shotgun) carried and available on site for security force members.

Confirm that the security force is equipped with two channel portable radios required by Appendix B.

- 3.0 Confirm that section 2.8.4 (qualification record) is applicable to this section.
- 3.10 Records of initial certification and requalification of crucial tasks must be retained on site for a minimum of 2 years.
