AEC REGULATORY STAFF'S RESPONSE TO "MOTION OF CONSUMERS POWER COMPANY TO IMPOSE THE BURDEN OF PROOF ON THE PROPONENT OF AN ORDER SUSPENDING, REVOKING OR OTHERWISE MODIFYING CONSTRUCTION PERMIT NOS. 81 and 82"

Under date of June 10, 1974, Consumers Power Company ("licensee") has asked the Board to place the "burden of proof" upon the proponent of the show cause order involved in this proceeding.

Section 2.732 of the Commission's Rules of Practice (10 CFR §2.732) provides as follows:

"Unless otherwise ordered by the presiding officer, the applicant or the proponent of an order has the burden of proof."

In view of this provision, the Staff believes it clear that the "burden of proof", used in the sense of the ultimate risk of non-persuation, is proper'y that of any proponent of the show cause

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order and not that of the licensee. In this connection it should be noted that the Regulatory Staff is not the proponent of this show cause order, as has been brought out on more than one occasion (see, e.g., prehearing transcript, page 49). In all events, because of the clear of 10 CFR §2.732, the Staff supports the licensee's request.
