


for September 10, 1980. The Staff suggests that if Petitioner filed her contentions by August 22, 1980, the other parties could file responses by September 4, 1980, giving the Board some time for consideration prior to the prehearing conference.

The Staff opposes Petitioner's request that an attorney be made available to her. Based on the advice of the Comptroller General of the United States and the Commission's clear reading of the legislative history associated with the fiscal year 1980 appropriations legislation, the Commission has only recently declined to consider Intervenor funding. Metropolitan Edison Company (Three Mile Island Nuclear Station, Unit No. 1), CLI-80-19, 11 NRC 700 (1980).

CONCLUSION

For the foregoing reasons, the Staff does not oppose a reasonable extension of time for filing contentions, but believes the Board should deny Petitioner's request that an attorney be made available to her.


