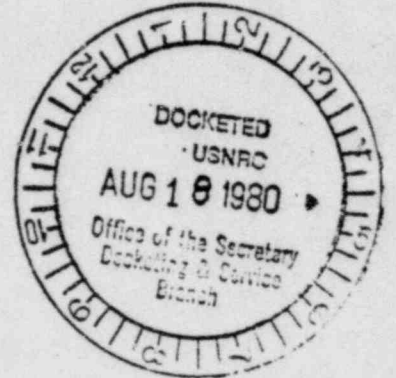

RESTART HEARING TRANSCRIPT




