In reference to our export license application dated August 6, 1979 and Mr. Peterson's letter of February 29, 1980, we are enclosing a revised application for the export of tritium gas to an SPL branch plant in the Dominican Republic.

The enclosed application differs from the previous one in two significant areas:

- a) Total annual tritium requirements have been reduced to 250,000 curies.
- b) The tritium will be shipped adsorbed on uranium rather than as bulk gas.

The first change reflects our intention not to participate in the market for GTLS in LCD watches. The second change is in response to the U.S. government position regarding preferred export forms for tritium.

We hope the enclosed application will meet with the approval of all agencies.
