In your April 8, 1980 letter you expressed concern about drunkenness at the Pilgrim Nuclear Fower Plant alleged in newspaper articles which you enclosed.

In response to your concerns I advised by letter, dated May 1, 1980, that the NRC was investigating similar allegations contained in newspaper articles. I also advised that you would be informed of the results of the investigation. The investigation has been completed and a report, dated June 17, 1980, of the investigation is enclosed.

Because the NRC has great concern for safe operation of nuclear power plants, I am reased to report that the investigation found none of the allegations presented to the newspaper articles to be substantiated and that no apparent items of non-compliances with the NRC regulatory requirements were identified.
