SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE UNIVERSITY OF WASHINGTON

- 2. In Article II The Period of Performance, the date " September 30, 1982" is substituted for the date " April 30, 1980 ".
- In Article III Consideration, the sum "\$ 262,252.00 is substituted for the sum "\$207,252.00".
