On April 29, 1980, Mississippi Power & Light Company notified Mr. M. Hunt of your office of a Potentially Reportable Deficiency (PRD) at the Grand Gulf Nuclear Station (GGNS) construction site. The deficiency concerns nonconformances associated with calibration services provided to MP&L by Computer Sciences Corporation (CSC). These nonconformances were noted during an April, 1980, MP&L audit of the CSC calibration facility, NSTL Station, Mississippi.

Our evaluation of the results of the investigation into this condition has not been completed. To date, however, no significant deficiencies have been identified which would constitute an adverse safety impact on MP&L equipment.

We expect to submit our final report by September 30, 1980.
