By letter, dated May 17, 1980, Wisconsin Electric Power Company, et al. (Applicants) withdrew their application to construct and operate the Haven Nuclear Plant. The site was located approximately 5 miles north of Sheboygan, Wisconsin, on the western shore of Lake Michigan. On July 30, 1980, the NRC Atomic Safety and Licensing Board granted the Applicant's May 17, 1980 request to terminate the construction permit proceeding in its "Order Dismissing the Proceeding."

Accordingly, the Commission considers the Haven construction permit application to be withdrawn and the corresponding licensing proceeding to be terminated.
