The following items are being sent to you under separate cover:

- 1. Your standard label tape WSZ004 containing:
 - a) File 1 with DSN=ORFAD.II.FORTRAN, the complete ORFAD program.
 - b) File 2 with DSN=EXAMPLE.JCL, an example of JCL used here for running ORFAD.
 - c) File 3 with DSN=EXAMPLE.DATA, an example of input data to ORFAD.
 - d) File 4 with DSN=NEWBRG59.MET.DATA, one year's meteorological data in the form required for ORFAD. This file is for Stewart AFB, Newburg, N.Y., 1959.
- 2. For reference, the tape copying job printout. On our system, DEN=3 refers to 1600 BPI.
- 3. A description of the meteorological data format used in ORFAD. We have found it necessary to go to a standard format because of the wide variety of formats in which data has been received.
- 4. A sample ORFAD input form. We find this a convenience in keeping the input data organized. You may have a previous copy; the sample is current.
- 5. A partial copy of the ORFAD II User's Manual. While this is not complete, or even final, it will explain the basis for the current ORFAD.
- 6. An example run with ORFAD using Files 1, 2, 3, and 4 above. Plots have been included for comparison in case you have the DISSPLA plotting system available.
