Subject: Beaver Valley Power Station - Unit No. 2 Docket No. 50-412 Environmental Qualification of Safety -Related Equipment

In response to Nuclear Regulatory Commission Letter dated 10/1/80 "Environmental Qualification of Safety -Related Equipment", we have prepared the attached information for voluntary submittal to the NRC. Please note that the veniors have not been contacted relative to the NRC involvement. There may be commercial ramifications. At the present time, we have not committed to a qualification test program to upgrade the Westinghouse (NSSS) scope of supply. We are currently in the process of reviewing the Westinghouse IEEE 323-19,4 program (Reference NS-TMA-2332) as it applies to the Beaver Valley Unit No. 2 Facility.
