AMENDMENT TO FACILITY OPERATING LICENSE

Amendment No. 48 License No. DPR-51

- 1. The Nuclear Regulatory Commission (the Commission) has found that:
 - A. The filing by Arkansas Power & Light Company (the licensee) dated February 26, 1980, as revised April 30, 1980, complies with the standards and requirements of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended (the Act), and the Commission's rules and regulations set forth in 10 CFR Chapter I;
 - B. The facility will operate in conformity with the filing, the provisions of the Act, and the rules and regulations of the Commission;
 - C. There is reasonable assurance (i) that the activities authorized by this amendment can be conducted without endangering the health and safety of the public, and (ii) that such activities will be conducted in compliance with the Commission's regulations;
 - D. The issuance of this amendment will not be inimical to the common defense and security or to the health and safety of the public; and
 - E. The issuance of this amendment is in accordance with 10 CFR Part 51 of the Commission's regulations and all applicable requirements have been satisfied.
- Accordingly, Facility Operating License No. DPR-51 is hereby amended by adding paragraph 2.c.(5) to read as follows:

Safeguards Contingency Plan

The licensee shall fully implement and maintain in effect all provisions of the Commission-approved Safeguards Contingency Plan, including amendments

and changes made pursuant to the authority of 10 CFR 50.54(p). The approved Contingency Plan consists of documents withheld from public disclosure pursuant to 10 CFR 2.790(d) identified as "Arkansas Nuclear Station Safeguards Contingency Plan" Revision 1, dated February 26, 1980, revised by Revision 2 page changes dated April 30, 1980, and submitted pursuant to 10 CFR 73.40. The Contingency Plan shall be fully implemented, in accordance with 10 CFR 73.40(b), within 30 days of this approval by the Commission.

3. This license amendment is effective as of the date of issuance.

AMENDMENT TO FACILITY OPERATING LICENSE

Amendment No. 18 License No. NPF-6

- 1. The Nuclear Regulatory Commission (the Commission) has found that:
 - A. The filing by Arkansas Power & Light Company (the licensee) dated February 26, 1980, as revised April 30, 1980, complies with the standards and requirements of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended (the Act), and the Commission's rules and regulations set forth in 10 CFR Chapter I;
 - B. The facility will operate in conformity with the filing, the provisions of the Act, and the rules and regulations of the Commission;
 - C. There is reasonable assurance (i) that the activities authorized by this amendment can be conducted without endangering the health and safety of the public, and (ii) that such activities will be conducted in compliance with the Commission's regulations;
 - D. The issuance of this amendment will not be inimical to the common defense and security or to the health and safety of the public; and
 - E. The issuance of this amendment is in accordance with 10 CFR Part 51 of the Commission's regulations and all applicable requirements have been satisfied.
- Accordingly, Facility Operating License No. NPF-6 is hereby amended as follows:
 - A. Renumber paragraph 2.D as 2.D.(1).
 - B. Add paragraph 2.D.(2) to read as follows:

POOR ORIGINAL

Arkansas Power and Light Company shall fully implement and maintain in effect all provisions of the Commission-approved Safeguards Contingency Plan, including amendments and changes made cursuant to the authority of 10 CFR 50.54(p). The approved Contingency Plan consists of documents withheld from public disclosure pursuant to 10 CFR 2.790(d) and identified as "Arkansas Nuclear Station Safeguards Contingency Plan" Revision 1, dated February 26, 1980, revised by Revision 2 page changes dated April 30, 1980, and submitted pursuant to 10 CFR 73.40. The Contingency Plan shall be fully implemented, in accordance with 10 CFR 73.40(b), within 30 days of this approval by the Commission.

3. This license amendment is effective as of the date of issuance.
