Dear Mr. Ahearne:

It is most urgent that the NRC respond to a wide segment of people who feel a strong need for Unit 1 at TMI to be re-started. This unjust and discriminating decision to shut down the unit and to keep it shut down has already caused undue concerns and financial burdens on the people of the Three Mile Island area. There is no substantial reason for delaying the restart of TMI-1. Many other power plants across the nation have made the required modifications, while in operation. I feel that TMI-1 should be given this same opportunity. The nuclear industry has learned a tremendous amount from the TMI-2 incident: and is continuing to make a safe way of producing electricity even safer.

Please consider the consequences of not allowing TMI-1 to return to full service. I am a most ardent supporter of nuclear power operations; and am appealing to the best judgement of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission to restart Unit 1 at TMI.
