012 On 15 September 1980 it was discovered that samples were not obtained for the month of August from Test Well #4. This created an event contrary to Environmental Technical Specification 3.1.5. The non-collection of those samples did not result from operation of Crystal River #3, nor is operation of the plant affected by it. There has been no discharge of waste water from CR-3 to the referenced ponds since August 24, 1979. This is the sixth occurrence for this well and the seventh report under this specification.

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110 The apparent cause of this event is attributed to elimination of Test Well sites due to canal modification construction. The elimination of Test Well #4 was originally reported in LER 80-011/04L-0. Test Well 4B was established on 8/16/80. Sampling for September will include Test Well 4B. The revision corrects the report date, failure data and supplementary information of 80-040/04L-1, dated 10/24/80.

Occurrence Date: August 7, 1980 (determined at plant site September 15, 1980).

Identification of Occurrence:

Contrary to Environmental Technical Specification 3.1.5, a representative sample was not obtained for August from Test Well #4.

Conditions Prior to Occurrence:

N/A.

Description of Occurrence:

The August sample at Well #4 was not collected because site construction activities have eliminated the well site.

Description of Apparent Cause:

The required construction activity is part of the canal modification at the Crystal River site.

Analysis of Occurrence:

The noncompliance did not result from the operation of Crystal River #3, nor is operation of the plant affected by it. There have been no discharges of waste water to the referenced ponds since August 24, 1979. Well #4 has been out of service since February 1980, resulting in a Licensee Event Report each month it is out of service.

Corrective Action:

Test Well #4B was established on August 16, 1980 to replace Test Well #4. This revision corrects the report date, corrective action, and failure data of 80-040/04L-1, dated October 24, 1980.

Failure Data:

This is the sixth report for Test Well 4 and the seventh occurrence reported under this specification.
