

This letter represents a noncompliance report as required by Part !!, Paragraph A.2 of the above referenced Permit.

On Thursday October 30, 1980, routine sampling at sample point 002, sanitary sewage effluents, resulted in a pH determination of 5.2. Permit 'aits are 6.0 - 9.0 standard units. Investigation of this violation has releated that the Sewage Treatment Plant (STP) had undergone a minor system upset. The probable cause of this upset is the construction activities underway to expand the facility which will give us a greatly increased capability under normal conditions. This expansion has been necessitated by a Nuclear Regulatory Commission requirement to construct an Emergency Response Center. Sanitary waste from this complex is to be routed to the existing but expanded sewage treatment plant.

This phase of construction on the STP facility involves electrical hookup and earth work. It is suspected that influent wastewater was shut off inadvertently during the electrical work. With no flow through the facility and continued operation of the air pumps on the facility, a processing alteration occurred.

CONTACTIC TES SYSTEM

These construction activities should end by mid-November, 1980. In the meanwhile, surveillance on the STP will be increased from four to six daily inspections in an effort to restore its normal operation in spice of the construction-activities in the area.
