to Applicants' Third Set of Interrogatories to CFUR and Requests to Produce.

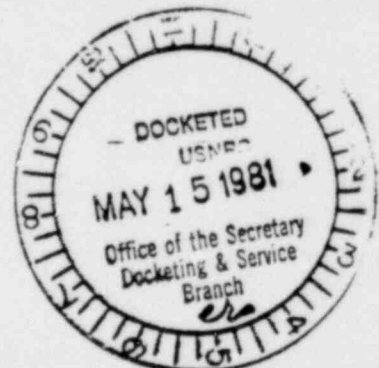

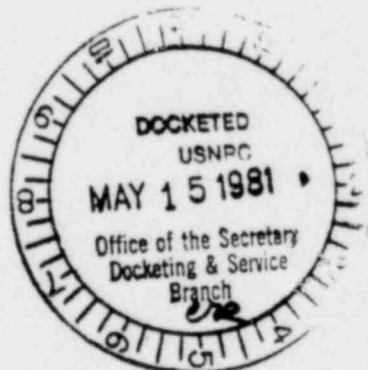
