

MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

People of the State of Illinois, by its attorney, TYRONE C. FAHNER, Attorney General of the State of Illinois, hereby moves the Board for an extension of time within which to file responses to NIPSCO's Second Set of Interrogatories. Counsel for NIPSCO previously indicated that he had no objection to the State's filing responses on June 3, 1981, three weeks after their due date. However, as of this date it is clear to the undersigned that dditional time is needed to adequately respond. The interrogatories are all of a technical nature, requiring consultation with others and the expenditure of significant amounts of time. Because counsel for NIPSCO has informed the undersigned that he does not agree to a further extension of time, Illinois respectfully requests that the Board grant a period of fourteen days from this date within which to file responses to NIPSCO's Second Set of Interrogatories.
